House #5: 10 Neds Lane - Continue on Ridgebury Road for 1/10 mile to next street, Neds Mountain. Go right on Neds Mountain. Continue for ½ mile to Neds Lane. Go right on Neds Lane and make immediate right between stone pillars and park on lawn. Please pull in straight and park around pool perimeter.

This custom Nantucket shingle style residence was designed by the homeowner Eileen Segalman, a well-known local interior designer. In order to realize her vision and design, the homeowner worked with Lynne Persan of Building Designs LLC to engineer working architectural drawings that were then constructed by David Adams of Design Builders & Simplicity and elegance with a contemporary flare Remodeling, Inc. define all of the interior spaces of this family home where Ms. Segalman lives with her husband and three young children. The children in the family have been beautifully captured in a hand painted photograph taken by local photographer Laurie Klein. The photo hangs over the unique gas fireplace with stainless steel surround created by Danbury Sheet Metal. The kitchen in this unusual home is a distinct family space that was designed as a gathering place with a sitting room, fireplace, and breakfast area, all well defined by a vaulted ceiling. This area smoothly transitions to a triple tray ceiling with recessed lighting to define the kitchen work area. The homeowner, whose background is in kitchen design, challenged herself to create a kitchen with the most open plan possible to take full advantage of the breathtaking views outside and the natural light that flows through the space. The result is a contemporary kitchen inspired by French Deco and South Beach with three sets of French doors, two islands and not a single wall cabinet. Ms. Segalman went to Christie Schultz of Kitchen Traditions in Danbury, with whom she often collaborates on design projects, and selected walnut cabinets with a custom espresso stain manufactured by Plain & Fancy. The countertops and backsplash are all Calcutta marble. The appliances are stainless steel and the kitchen features a Viking Professional Series range top, Viking Designer Series double wall oven and refrigerator. The first island is a clean-up island with a stainless steel sink that is flanked by Fisher and Paykel dishwasher drawers and contains dish and glass storage that would be traditionally located in wall cabinets. The second island functions as a prep area and contains a beverage refrigerator, microwave and prep sink and also serves as a counter for bar stools. Both islands are beautifully accented with Dornbracht fixtures, whose contemporary styling perfectly compliment this kitchen's feeling of calm and serenity.
